Building on the firm's commitments to justice, inclusion, and community, we focus our corporate citizenship efforts on supporting access and opportunity for underrepresented, under-resourced populations.



Since 2020, **20,100+ students** have participated in our literacy, STEAM, and legal career exploration programs.



In 2023, Kilpatrick attorneys and professional staff volunteered **11,586 hours**, a **26%** increase over last year.



8,620 students participated in Kilpatrick programs in 2023.



42 high school students from Boys & Girls Clubs in Atlanta and San Francisco experienced life at a law firm.



182 young adults and job seekers participated in career experience initiatives.



171,864 meals donated to support food security.



KTS Employee Financial Support Fund¹ is an independent 501(c)(3), assisting colleagues experiencing unexpected hardship events.



In 2023, the Kilpatrick Education & Opportunity Fund, powered by United Way of Greater Atlanta,² awarded grants to **5** innovative, local nonprofits.

1. The KTS Employee Financial Support Fund was established in 2020 to support Kilpatrick Townsend & Stockton LLP employees who experience unexpected financial hardship. The fund is an independent 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization, wholly funded by donations from Kilpatrick Townsend attorneys and professional staff. Grant decisions are made by an independent grant committee.
