

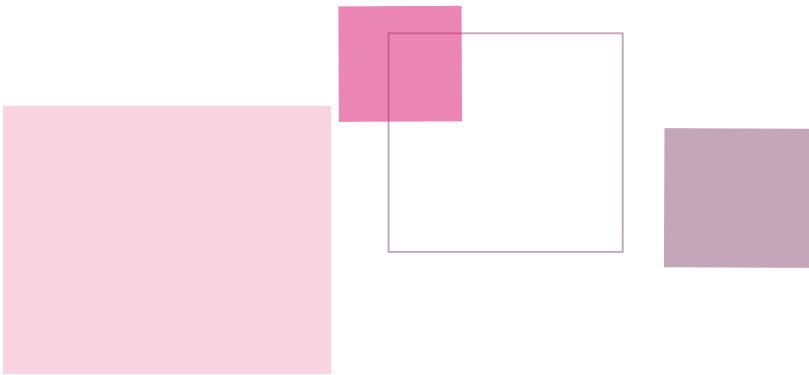


MOST INFLUENTIAL WOMEN IN ARIZONA
