Symposium 2017 | Keynote Address by Congressman Jamie Raskin, Summary

On October 27, 2017, Congressman Jamie Raskin of the U.S. House of Representatives delivered the lunchtime keynote address at The George Washington Law Review's Symposium, The Challenge of Crime in a Free Society: 50 Years Later.
