Prior to joining the firm, Joe served as a law clerk to the Honorable Marc T. Treadwell in the U.S. District Court for the Middle District of Georgia.

While in law school, Joe served as an extern to Judge Ethelyn N. Simpson and Judge Charles E. Auslander, III in the State Court of Athens-Clarke County in Athens, Georgia. He was also the Senior Articles Editor of the *Georgia Law Review*, a research assistant for Professor Lonnie T. Brown, and the recipient of the William K. Meadow Award, as the graduate "who best exemplifies the integrity, sense of responsibility, and high standards of the legal profession and has the keen sense of humor necessary to afford a proper human perspective to the resolution of legal problems."
