Such incentives include credits against income tax, payments in lieu of tax (PILOT) agreements, or reductions or eliminations of property tax for specified periods of time. Eligibility for incentives may be contingent on promising to employ a specified number of people, engaging in manufacturing activity, a specified degree of capital investment, or developing and cleaning up a contaminated area.
