## Charlie Henn Named Managing Intellectual Property's Georgia IP Litigator of the Year

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**ATLANTA (April 9)** – Kilpatrick Townsend & Stockton announced today that **Charlie Henn** was recognized by *Managing Intellectual Property* (*Managing IP*) as the **Georgia IP Litigator of the Year** at *Managing IP's* 2019 Americas Awards held in New York City on April 4.
