The firm was recognized at the 2016 North Carolina Legal Services Conference held at the International Civil Rights Museum in Greensboro, North Carolina.

Kilpatrick Townsend was recognized for its Education Justice project in partnership with Legal Aid and the Wake Forest School of Law and for dedicating more than 1,375 pro bono hours to Legal Aid clients since 2011.
