Kilpatrick Townsend's Rob Roy Smith Named One of the Country's Rising Stars by Law360

He has filed briefs before the United States Supreme Court and the United States Court of Federal Claims on a variety of issues, including tribal jurisdiction and fiduciary duty. Mr. Smith also has experience litigating cases under the Indian Arts and Crafts Act.
