BIPA Class Actions: Liability of Third-Party Vendors

There has been an explosion of class action litigation under Illinois's Biometric Information Privacy Act (BIPA). The decision by the Northern District of Illinois in *Ronquillo v. Doctor's Associates, LLC*, No. 21-C-4903, 2022 WL1016600 (N.D. Ill. Apr. 4, 2022), which ruled that section 15(b) of BIPA applies to third-party vendors with no direct employment relationship with a BIPA plaintiff, adds to the growing line of proplaintiff decisions under that statute.
