Prior to joining the firm, Mr. Galbraith served as the White House Associate Director of Intergovernmental Affairs and Public Engagement for President Barack Obama. At the White House, Galbraith analyzed and formulated political and policy recommendations for President Obama, Executive Branch Agencies, and Senior White House Officials on matters affecting tribal governments and Native American. He also served in the White House as a Deputy Associate Counsel for Presidential Personnel conducting backgrounds and vetting of political nominees.

Prior to his work at the White House, Galbraith served as an Assistant United States Attorney for the District of Arizona prosecuting a variety of crimes against the United States, and as a Legislative Assistant to former Senator Tim Johnson of South Dakota.
