Gautam Reddy focuses his practice on construction and infrastructure projects and government contracting. He has represented a wide variety of clients in the construction industry, including owners, EPC contractors, general contractors, subcontractors, and design professionals, both in the U.S. and internationally. His practice includes front-end contract drafting and negotiation, counseling clients during projects, and litigating cases in a variety of forums, including state and federal courts, domestic arbitration, international ICC arbitration, and the Civilian Board of Contract Appeals.

Gautam's project experience has included large industrial mills and processing facilities, airports, hospitals, transportation infrastructure, pipelines, commercial developments, university facilities, and mining projects.

Representative matters include:

- Representing an international EPC contractor in a €200 million-plus ICC arbitration of a dispute arising out of the construction of a large industrial facility in South America;
- Representing a large private owner in a \$100 million-plus arbitration regarding construction of a mining facility;
- Representing an EPC contractor in a \$165 million federal court litigation regarding a large industrial facility;
- Representing a general contractor on a \$25 million delay claim before the Civilian Board of Contract Appeals; and
- Representing a pipeline contractor in a jury trial in Colorado state court with over \$41 million in claims.
